INGREDIENTS

- 1.5 cups graham cracker crumbs
- 1/2 cup pecans
- 2 Tbsp. light brown sugar
- 6 Tbsp. butter, melted

FILLING

- 4 pkgs. (8 oz. ea.) cream cheese, softened
- 1 cup sugar
- 3 tsp. Spice Islands® pure vanilla extract
- 4 eggs, lightly beaten
- 1 cup (6 oz.) mini semisweet choc. chips

TOPPING

- 2 cups (16 oz.) sour cream
- 1/4 cup sugar

Place an ungreased 9-in. springform pan on a double thickness of heavy-duty foil (about 18 in. square). Securely wrap foil around pan.

In a small bowl, combine cracker crumbs, pecans (toasted/finely chopped) and brown sugar; stir in butter. Press onto bottom and 1-1/2 in. up the sides of prepared pan. Place on a baking sheet. Bake at 350°F for 5 minutes. Cool on a wire rack.

In a large bowl, beat the cream cheese, sugar and vanilla until smooth. Add eggs; beat on low speed just until combined. Fold in chocolate chips. Pour into crust. Place in a larger baking pan; add 1 in. of hot water to larger pan.

Bake at 325°F for 1-1/2 hours or until center is just set and top appears dull. In a small bowl, combine sour cream and sugar until smooth; spoon over hot cheesecake and spread to cover. Bake for 5 minutes longer or until topping is just set.

Remove springform pan from water bath. Cool on a wire rack for 10 minutes. Carefully run a knife around edge of pan to loosen; cool 1 hour longer. Refrigerate overnight. Garnish with candies. Yield: 16 servings.

INGREDIENTS

- 1.5 cups graham cracker crumbs
- 1/2 cup pecans
- 2 Tbsp. light brown sugar
- 6 Tbsp. butter, melted

FILLING

- 4 pkgs. (8 oz. ea.) cream cheese, softened
- 1 cup sugar
- 3 tsp. Spice Islands® pure vanilla extract
- 4 eggs, lightly beaten
- 1 cup (6 oz.) mini semisweet choc. chips

TOPPING

- 2 cups (16 oz.) sour cream
- 1/4 cup sugar

Place an ungreased 9-in. springform pan on a double thickness of heavy-duty foil (about 18 in. square). Securely wrap foil around pan.

In a small bowl, combine cracker crumbs, pecans (toasted/finely chopped) and brown sugar; stir in butter. Press onto bottom and 1-1/2 in. up the sides of prepared pan. Place on a baking sheet. Bake at 350°F for 5 minutes. Cool on a wire rack.

In a large bowl, beat the cream cheese, sugar and vanilla until smooth. Add eggs; beat on low speed just until combined. Fold in chocolate chips. Pour into crust. Place in a larger baking pan; add 1 in. of hot water to larger pan.

Bake at 325°F for 1-1/2 hours or until center is just set and top appears dull. In a small bowl, combine sour cream and sugar until smooth; spoon over hot cheesecake and spread to cover. Bake for 5 minutes longer or until topping is just set.

Remove springform pan from water bath. Cool on a wire rack for 10 minutes. Carefully run a knife around edge of pan to loosen; cool 1 hour longer. Refrigerate overnight. Garnish with candies. Yield: 16 servings.
